

Regulations Governing Sunny Glades

- Prospective members, visitors and members of other clubs are required to register at the office upon arrival. The appropriate fees are to be paid at that time. Casual visitors or guests of members should make their presence known to management upon arrival.
- Management reserves the right to refuse admittance to any person and to request anyone already admitted to leave for conduct, which in its sole discretion, is unbecoming a nudist. In case of expulsion, no payments received by management will be refunded.
- Sunny Glades is monitored with a security system and a gate at the front drive entrance. The gate is locked at 9 pm weekdays and 10 pm weekends. Day visitors must leave before times posted or will be subject to overnight fees. No exceptions will be made. Allowances will be made when Sunny Glades hosts special activities in the clubhouse. Please check at the office if clarification is required. Ring the front doorbell of the clubhouse to alert management if an emergency should arise.
- Sunny Glades operates as a "family atmosphere park". You are asked to always keep this in mind. Refrain from intimate behaviour ~ this includes the use of the whirlpool, swimming pool, pond and lawns while sunbathing, etc. This type of behaviour makes others uncomfortable and is not considered appropriate for a family setting.
- Sunny Glades is a nudist facility. The "Clothing for comfort" policy does not mean members/visitors do not participate in a nudist lifestyle. All members/visitors are required to adhere to the fundamentals of Sunny Glades.
- You must use a clean, dry towel to sit on when you are in the nude. This applies to anywhere in the clubhouse and when sitting at the picnic tables and park lawn chairs on the grounds. Considerate Nudists make this a general rule.
- Alcoholic beverages are permitted within campsites, rental units, picnic area, but NOT ALLOWED in the swimming pool area or whirlpool room. Use common sense and moderation. Drugs are illegal by law. Anyone in possession of or using drugs at Sunny Glades will be reported to the Authorities.
- Quiet time is from 11 pm to 8 am. All music and loud voices should cease at this time. Enjoy your late nights but be considerate of those who wish to sleep.
- Sunny Glades is also a conservation area. There are plants, trees, birds, and wildlife to observe. Please enjoy the nature. Feel privileged to view but do not destroy.
- Management, while attempting sincerely to make everyone's stay a pleasant one, is not responsible for loss, theft or damage to guests or members' belongings. Management is also not responsible for any personal injuries however caused.

- It is difficult to monitor all suspicious activity. Should you witness a person(s) obviously not from the park, on the grounds, please report to the office immediately in order that management may take further appropriate action.
- Everyone is emphatically requested to refrain from littering the grounds and hiking trails with pop/beer cans, bottles, cigarette butts and scraps of paper etc. There are containers provided at the bath house, volleyball court and pond. Remember, you benefit by keeping the grounds clean and tidy. TAKE PRIDE IN THE QUALITY OF SUNNY GLADES.
- Hikers are cautioned against going beyond the indicated inner park area in the nude. No chances should be taken in case of doubt. Therefore, take with you a minimum of clothing or towel when hiking along the edge of the woods or the perimeter of the property.
- The use of cameras/video cameras/cell phone cameras, while not prohibited, will remain under close supervision. Prior permission must be obtained from management and from persons within range of the camera. Distance yourself from other before using a cell phone.
- Children are always the responsibility of their parents.
- Sunny Glades has a smoke-free environment in the Club House, rental rooms and in the cottage. Everyone MUST abide by this rule.
- Sunny Glades maintains a "NO PET POLICY".
